



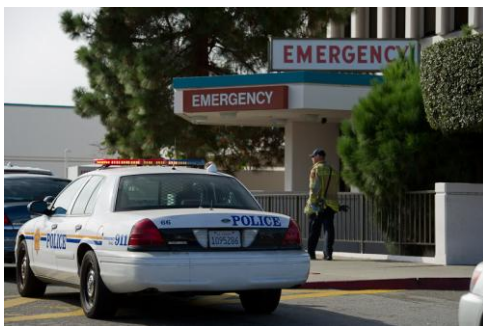
Doctors Medical Center Needs Our Help
